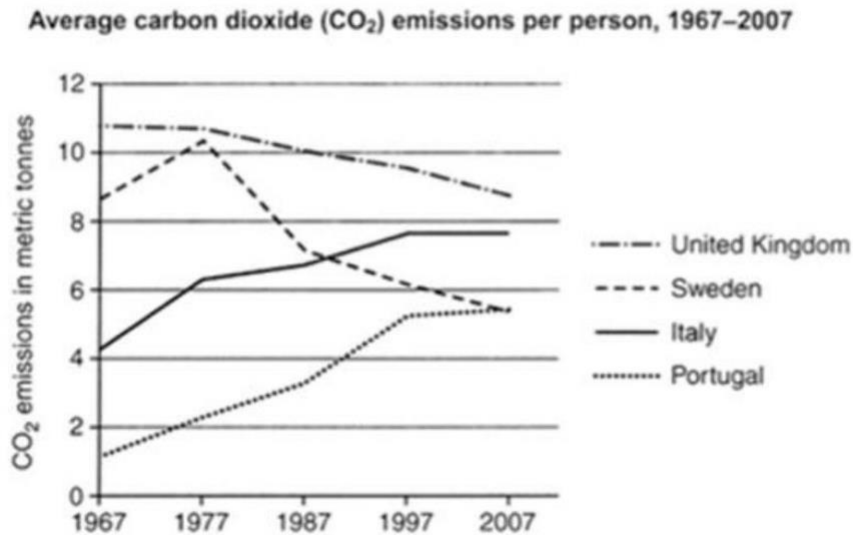
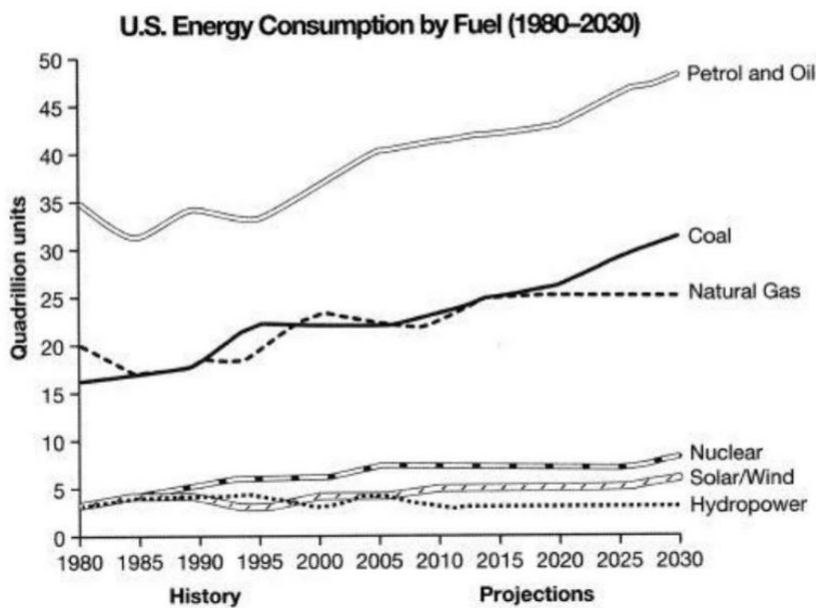

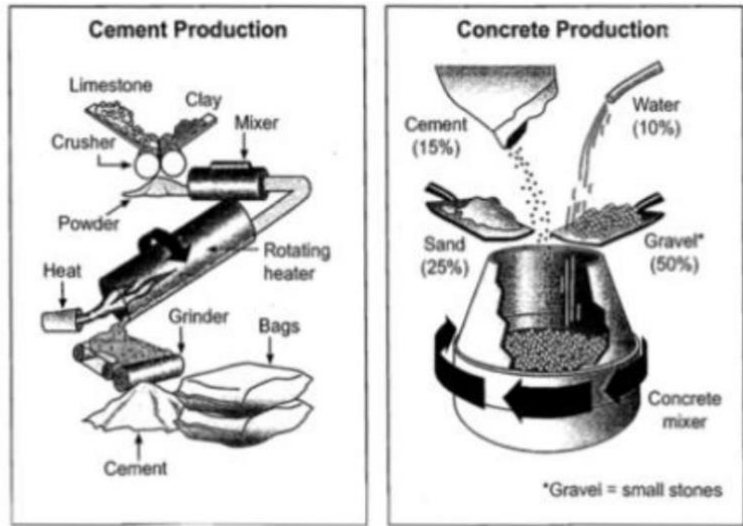


***“The graph below gives information from a 2008 report about consumption of energy in the USA since 1980 with projections until 2030.”***

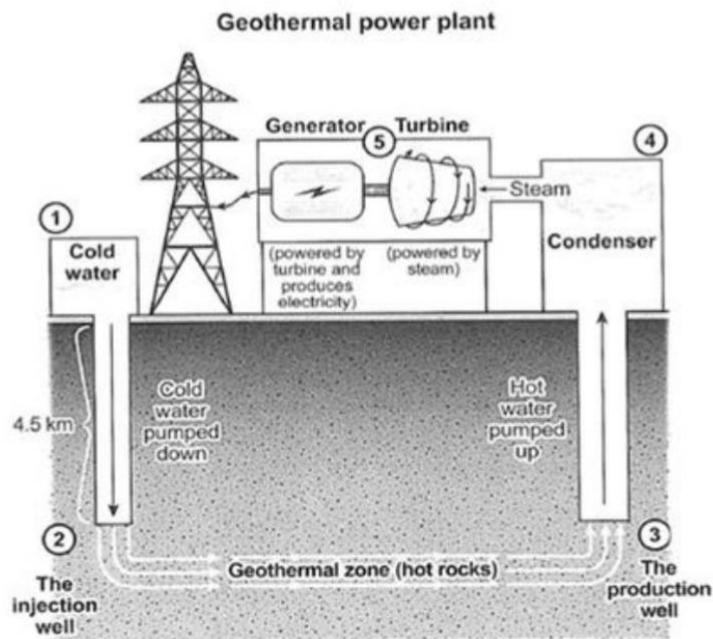

**“The diagrams below show the stages and equipment used in the cement-making process, and how cement is used to produce concrete for building purposes.”**

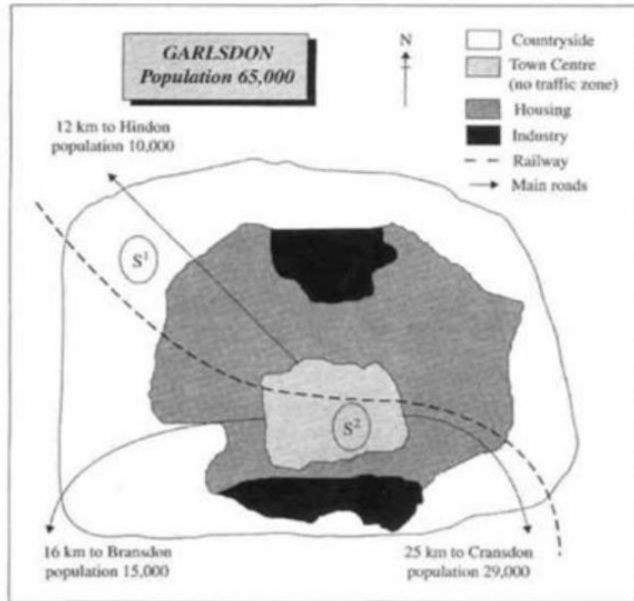


**The diagram below shows how geothermal energy is used to produce electricity.**

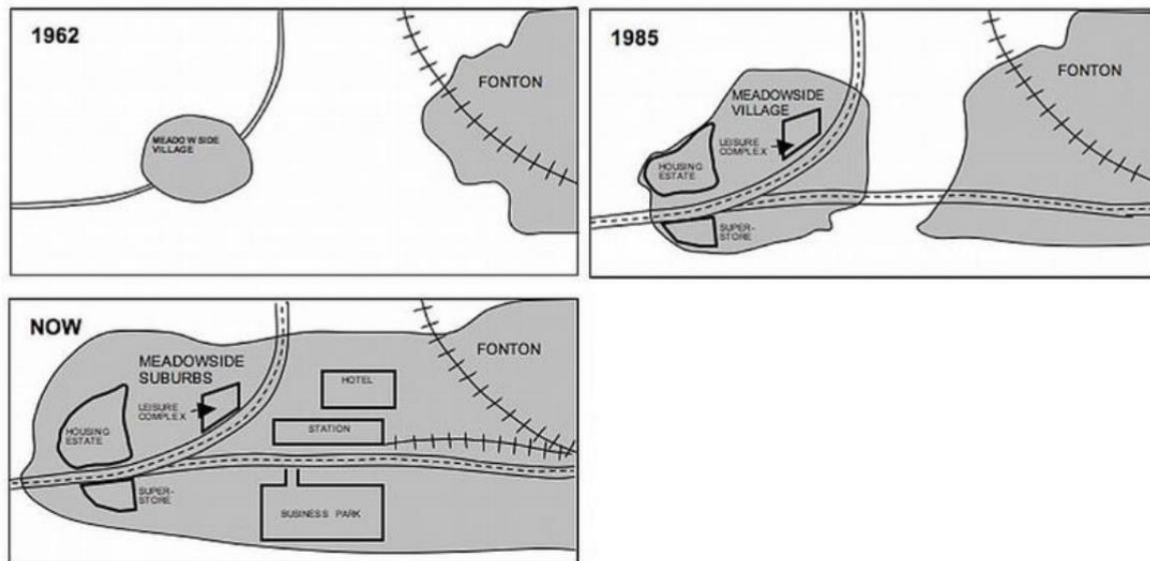

**“The map below is of the town of Garlsdon. A new supermarket (S) is planned for the town. The map shows two possible sites for that supermarket.”**



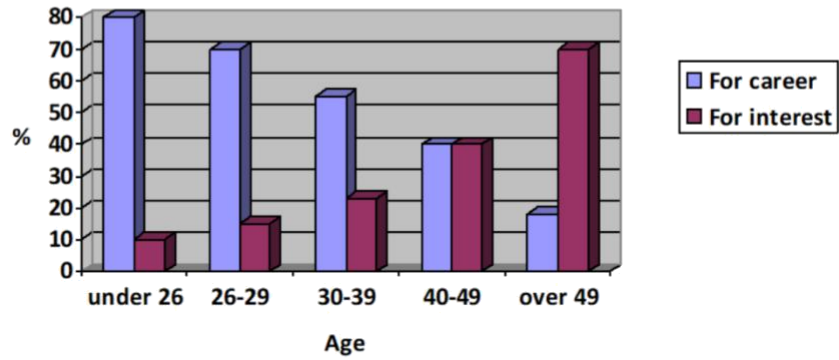

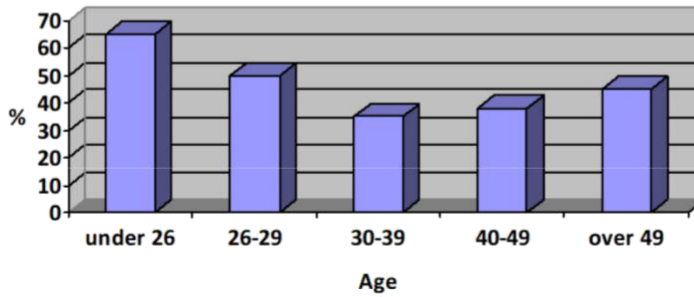

**Reasons for study according to age of student**

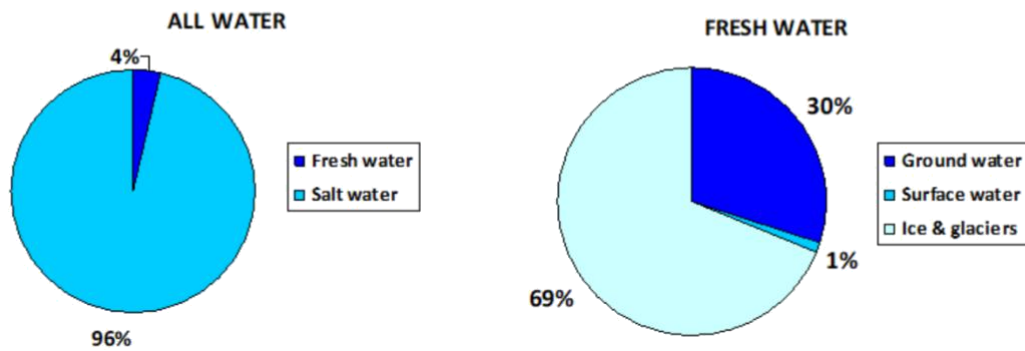


**Employer support, by age group  
(Time off and help with fees)**

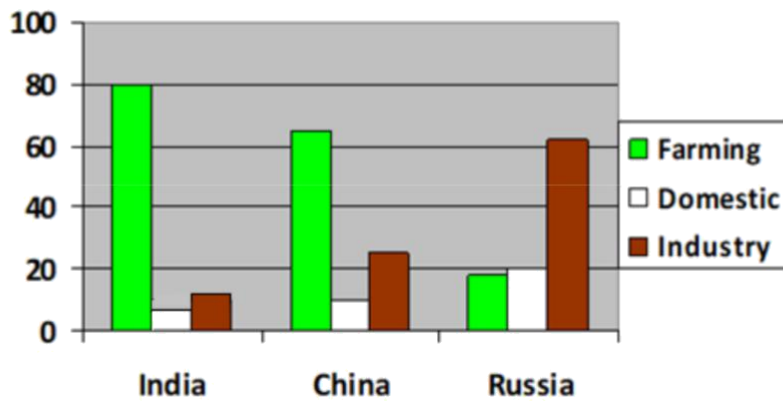


The charts below show how the world's water is distributed and how it is used in three countries.

### Percentages of the world's water



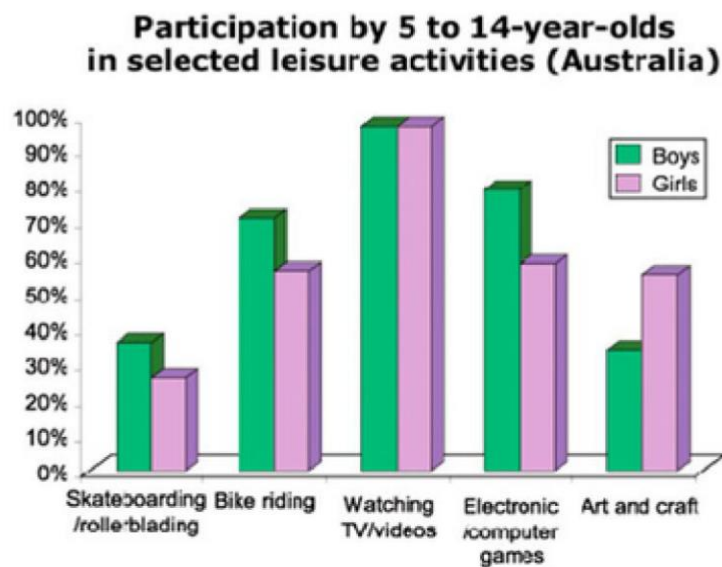
